Myanmar-focused SanThit Accelerator opens grant support for startups



MPE&VCA member venture capital firm, EME Myanmar, in partnership with Peace Foundation and Village Capital, has announced the launch of the SanThit Accelerator for 2022, welcoming Myanmar startups to be awards 30,000 each in grant funding.

For this year, the Myanmar-focused accelerator is taking up to 20 companies and encouraged to grow as high-impact, gender-inclusive startups .

More white collar jobs in the market whilst developments shape the employment landscape

An environment with a rich pool of skilled professionals in town and competitive salary packages has been fading in Myanmar since the economic deceleration in 2020 when Covid-19 took effect. Yet, 2023 is presenting an increase in job openings — a majority from local businesses — according to professionals in the employment sector.

Job recruitment has soared this year despite — or perhaps because of — less business competition in the country. This follows from many foreign corporations moving out, more qualified professionals leaving for better-promising job opportunities abroad, and the emergence of new local businesses.

"SME businesses have really taken off again. It is hard to believe because they're the least people who are going to spend on jobs, but they're doing it now," said Justin Sway, CEO of JobNet.com.mm, a platform for white-collar workers and Alote.com.mm dedicated to blue and grey-collar labour.

JobNet, which is already profitable, has gained new contracts this year, said Sway, likely triggered by a result of more local companies reactivating their business since late 2022. Its sector-agnostic platform and comparatively active presence in the market have combined to put JobNet on the radar of corporates and small, medium businesses when it comes to advertising job vacancies online.

Progress in the hiring landscape

The current number of active job posts on JobNet — white-collar positions for those who work in offices and have a higher education — indicates a 40 percent increase, reaching




